These reports contain the following information:

Student Assessment Data – Elementary and middle school assessment results on the Michigan Student Test of Educational Progress (M-STEP), high school assessment results on the M-STEP component of the Michigan Merit Exam (MME), and assessment results for students with disabilities on Michigan's Alternative Assessment Program (MI-Access).

- Presents achievement data for all four tested subjects (English language arts, mathematics, science, and social studies) compared to targets for all students as well as subgroups of students
- Helps parents understand achievement progress results within schools and compare these to district and state achievement results

Accountability Scorecard – Detail Data and Status

The Delton Kellogg Schools overall score of 68% equates to a Yellow. A ranking of Yellow is defined as Meeting Proficiency Improvement Targets. The Elementary, Middle School and High School also achieved rankings of Yellow, while the DK Academy received a ranking of Red. The Delton Kellogg Schools continue our focus of "Success for All" students, while also analyzing how we can improve our scores in the sub categories.

- Reports percentage of core academic classes taught by teachers not considered highly qualified to teach such classes

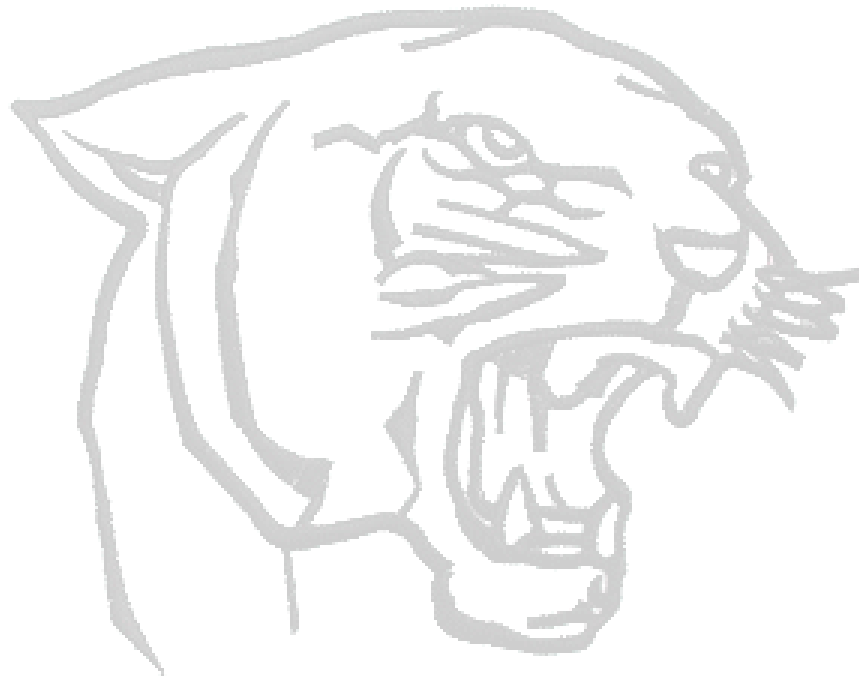
NAEP Data (National Assessment of Educational Progress)
