We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER) which provides key information on the 2015-16 educational progress for the Delton Kellogg Elementary School. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. The Elementary School has received an Overall Score of 62.5% which is a Yellow Ranking (Meeting Proficiency Improvement Targets). The Elementary scored Green in ELA, Math, and Science, but was marked down to a Yellow due to performance in sub categories of the Bottom 30 and Students with Disabilities. We continue to increase our rigor, offer more individual learning through 1:1 devices, increase our summer school offerings, as well as planning additional support for our students to allow them to become more successful. We have targeted many of our lower achieving students and have worked through the use of our Child Study Team, Title I Program and tutoring opportunities to help our students close the gap with other students.

State law requires that we also report additional information:

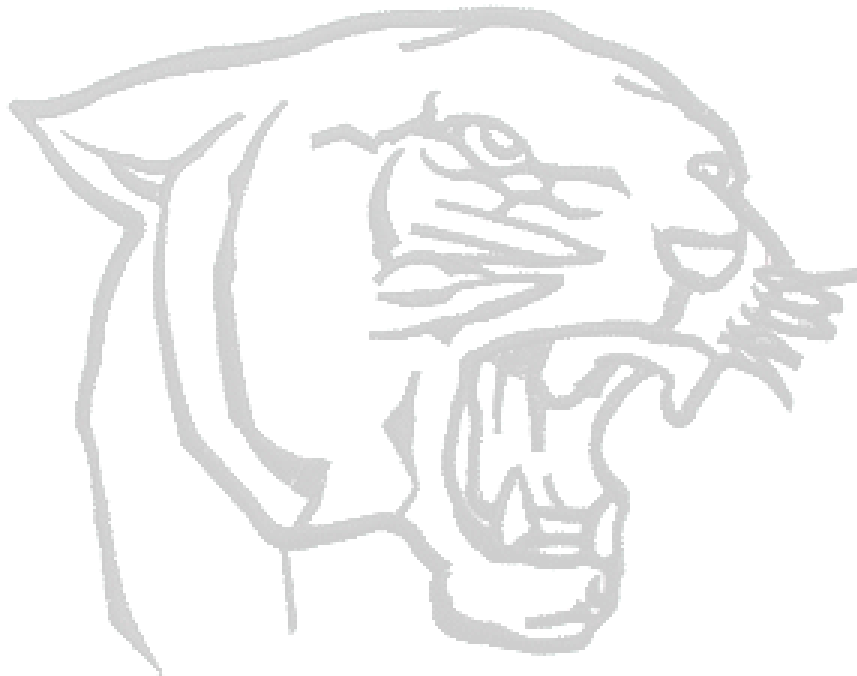
1. Delton Kellogg Elementary School serves all students in grades Pre-school – 4<sup>th</sup> grades. Parents are provided the opportunity annually to give input into the selection of the next year's teacher.
2. The DKES School Improvement Plan was updated in 2015-2016 for improvement in the core academic areas and in implementing technology for each student across all grade levels. It was filed with the Michigan Department of Education.
3. Delton Kellogg Schools have one Elementary School. DKES is for grades Pre School – 4<sup>th</sup> grade.
4. A copy of the core curriculum and description of its implementation and how it may vary from the state's model are available by contacting the school office.
5. Delton Kellogg Elementary School uses the following local data: DIBELs (Dynamic Indicators of Basic Early Literacy Skills), Fountas and Pinnell, Writing Rubrics, AVRMS Math Screeners, Everyday Math Assessments, i-Ready (On-line testing) and the State of Michigan's State Wide Assessment Program. Our local data is demonstrating that our student's proficiency is improving in the areas of Reading and Math. As a building we were performing similar to the State of Michigan on the MEAP tests, but performed below the State on the new MSTEP.
6. Parent Teacher conferences were attended at a rate of 94% in the fall of 2016 and 96% in the Spring 2016.

Delton Kellogg Elementary School is continually working on increasing our student success through curriculum and instructional improvement, integrating technology, and social and emotional growth. This is all possible due to our great partnership with our community members, parents, and fine teaching staff. At Delton Kellogg Elementary School we are SK2R! (Safe, Kind, Respectful and Responsible).
