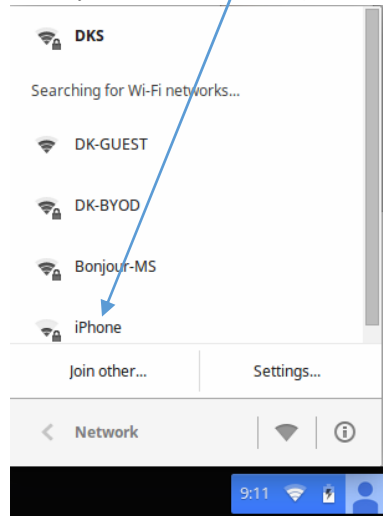
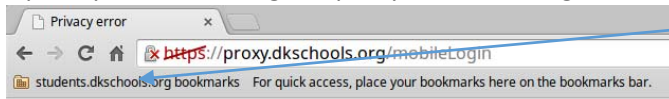


# How to connect your Chromebook to the internet from home

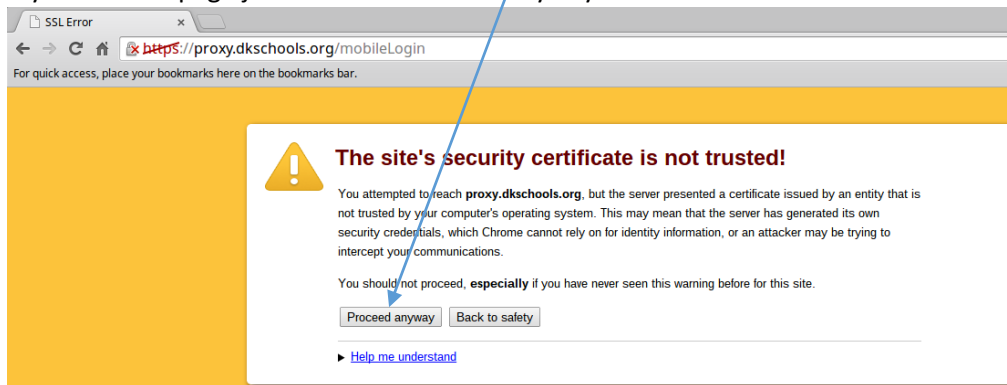
1. Log into your Chromebook
2. Make sure that you are connected to your home wireless network
  - a. Click on the wireless symbol on the lower right hand corner
  - b. Click on “Connected to...”
  - c. Now look for your wireless SSID (ex. iPhone is what this home wireless network SSID is)



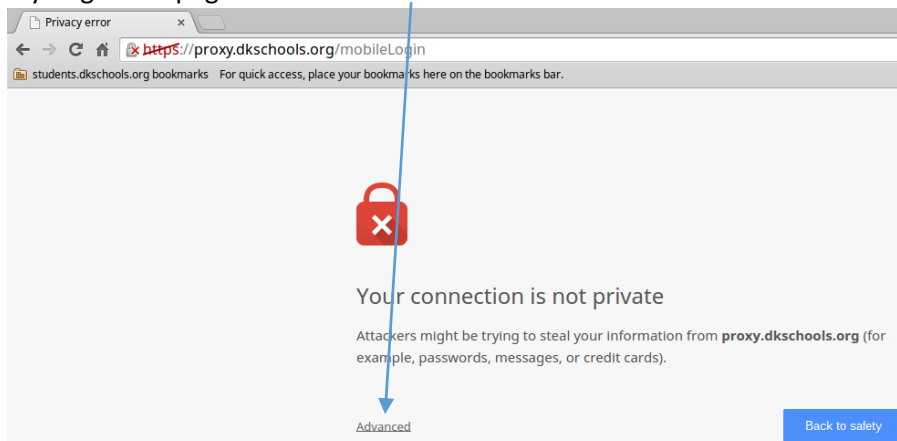
3. Open up Chrome and go to proxy.dkschools.org/mobileLogin (for student it's bookmark for you)



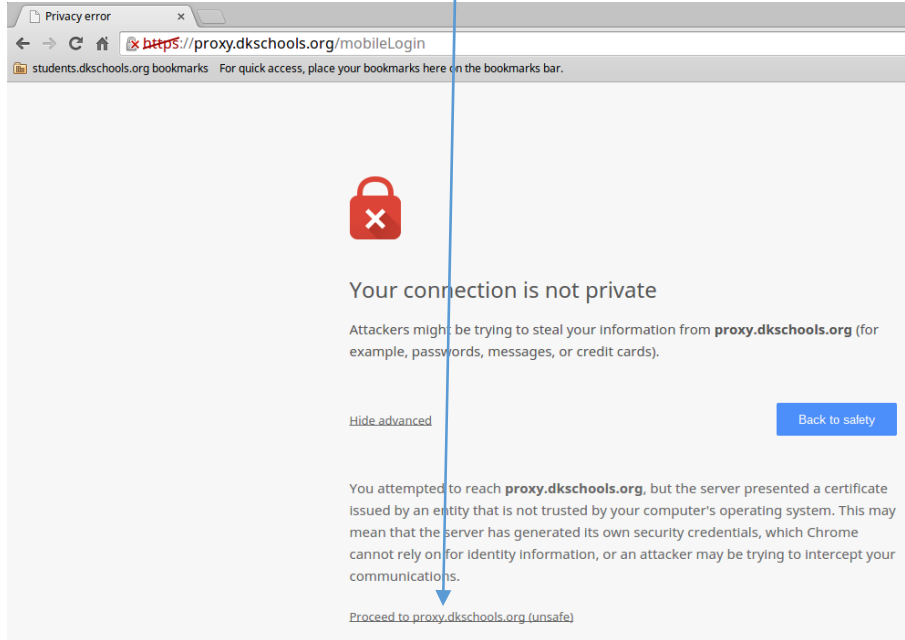
- a. If you see this page just click on “Proceed anyway”



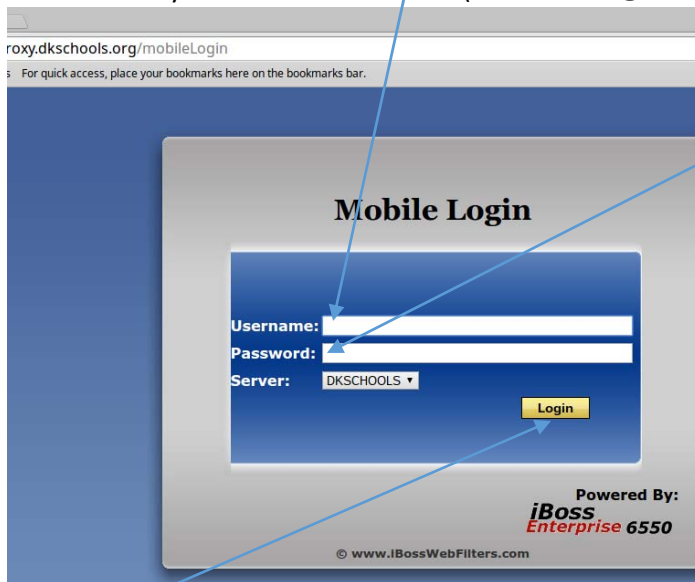
- b. If you get this page click on “Advanced”



- c. Then click on “Proceed to proxy.dkschools.org (unsafe)”



- d. Now enter in your network username (without the @students.dkschools.org) and password



- e. Click on “Login”
- f. If you have successfully login, chrome will redirect you to dkschools.org. Now you should be able to get to the internet. Test the internet connection by going to yahoo.com
