SUMMARY:

To assist in providing safe transportation of students to and from designated locations (am and pm).

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Maintains good student conduct on the bus.
- Is alert to any conditions in the loading and unloading area which may present a danger to students.
- Communicates in an appropriate fashion with students, parents and employees.
- Assists driver and students when needed.
- Other duties as assigned by the Superintendent or his/her designee.

SUPERVISOR RESPONSIBILITIES:

Supervises students during bus transportation.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS: To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skill, and/or ability required. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

EDUCATION and/or EXPERIENCE:

Associates degree or 60 semester credits at a four-year accredited college or university, or successfully passed a state approved skills test; previous experience with remedial reading students or a combination of experience and post high school training is preferred.

LANGUAGE SKILLS:

Ability to read, write and comprehend simple instructions, short correspondence, and memos. Ability to effectively present information in one-on-one and small group situations to staff, parents, students and administrators.

REASONING ABILITY:

Ability to apply common sense understanding to carry out detailed but uninvolved written or oral instructions. Ability to deal with problems involving a few concrete variables in standardized situations.

OTHER SKILLS and ABILITIES:

Ability to maintain composure under stressful conditions. Ability to develop effective working relationships with students, staff and the school community. Ability to communicate clearly and concisely, both orally and in writing. Ability to perform duties with awareness of all district requirements and Board of Education policies.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS:

The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is frequently required to reach with hands and arms. The employee frequently is required to stand, walk, sit, and talk or hear.
